

219s-06 Watermark Dolman Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Julien [95% silk, 5% polyester; 192 yds/176m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #82 mint green, 8 skeins [295g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4 buttons (11.5mm/0.45")

Finished measurements:

- bust 87cm/34.3"
- back length 48cm/18.9"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 30 sts and 15 rows
- pattern stitch B: 32 sts and 14 rows
- pattern stitch C: 32 sts and 10.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body (back & front) & sleeves: ?Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitches A, B & C. Work pattern stitch A at each cuff. Work edging at each location indicated according to schematics & chart. Left front/back & sleeve is mirror image of right except that there should be no buttonholes on left side.

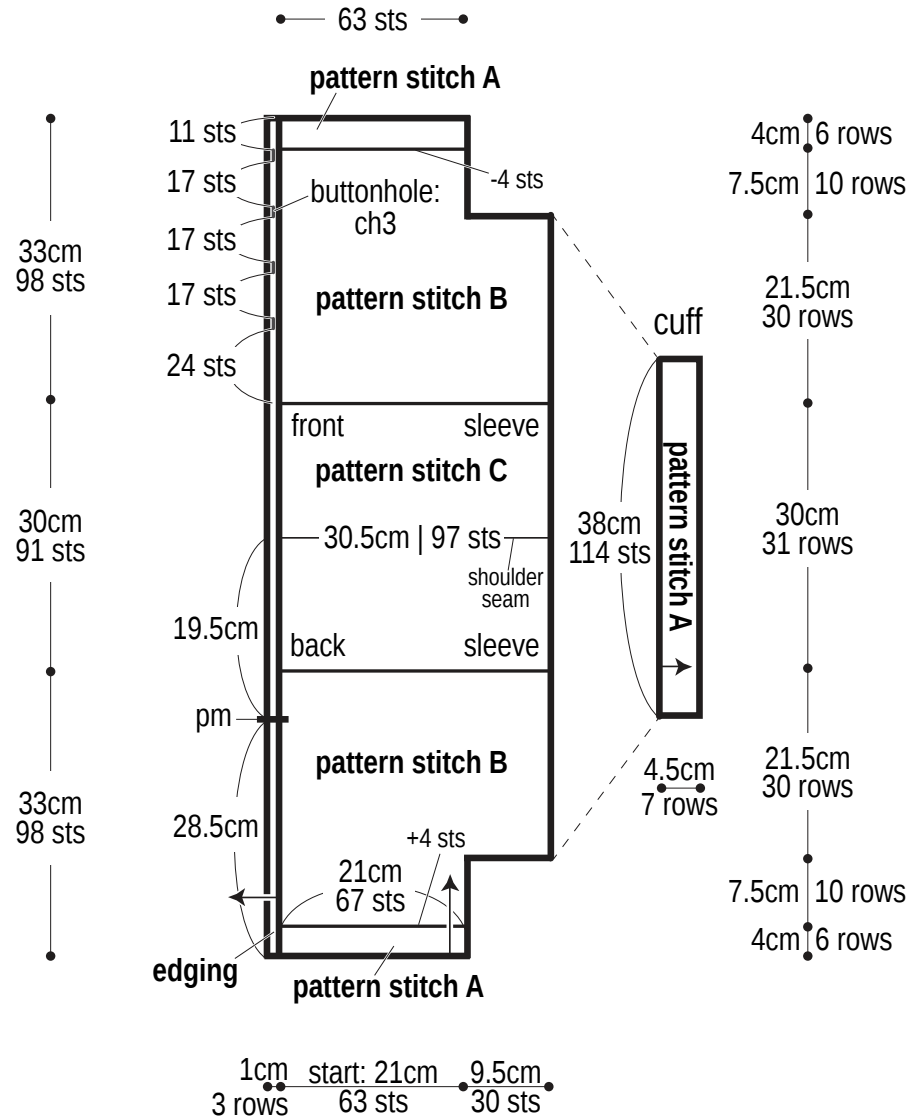
Finishing: Seam left & right back together from hem until marker using whipstitch.

Abbreviations:

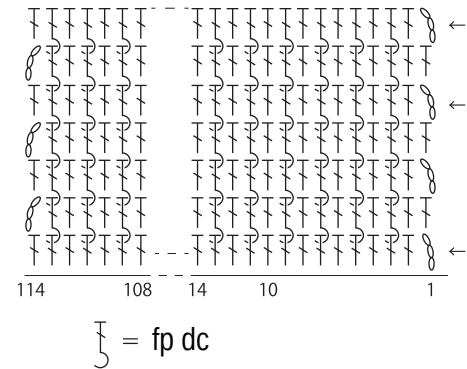
ch = chain dc = double crochet (US) fp = front post pm = place marker

Right body & right sleeve 2.3mm hook

※Work left body & sleeve in mirror image, but do **not** work buttonholes in left front.



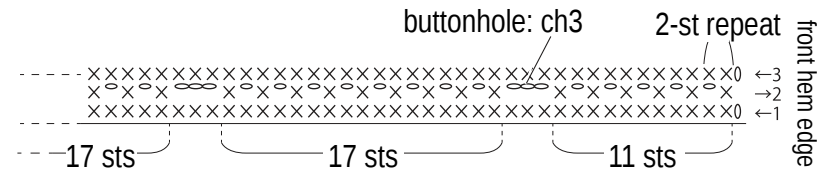
Cuffs: pattern stitch A



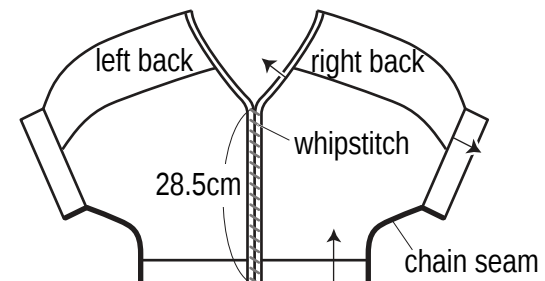
