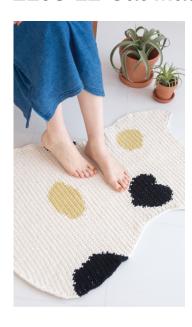
219s-12 Cat Mat



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Cotton [100% cotton; 60 yds/55m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - version A:

- version B:
- color #1 milk white, 13 skeins [380g]
- color #1 milk white, 1 skein [20g]

• color #4 black, 3 skeins [70g]

- color #14 ultramarine, 15 skeins [445g]
- color #12 French mimosa, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

• 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 55cm/21.7"
- length 79cm/31.1"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• single crochet (US): 14 sts and 15 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Note 1: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

❖Note 2: Work entire mat with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Note 3: In this pattern, "intarsia" refers to colorwork where the resting color is **not** carried along with the work, while "tapestry crochet" refers to working the active color over the resting yarn.

Body of mat: Work foundation chain to begin. For version A, work in sc, tapestry crochet, and intarsia where shown in chart. For version B, work in sc and intarsia. Work 1 round of sc edging around entire outer edge of body.

Tail: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc and intarsia as shown. Work slip stitch around outer edge of tail.

Finishing: Attach tail to cat as shown in finishing schematic.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain sc = single crochet (US)
