# 219ss-05 Chanvre Shrug



#### **Suggested yarn:**

- Pierrot Yarns Chanvre [100% linen; 241 yds/220m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #04 sepia moon, 10 skeins [395g]
  - color #09 violet gray, 10 skeins [395g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

• 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

#### **Finished measurements:**

· Please see schematics.

### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 28 sts and 10.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

### **Summary**

\*Note 1: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

\*Note 2: Work entire garment with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of color #04 and 1 strand of color #09).

**Body of shrug:** Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch.


**Finishing:** Fold corners of shrug along fold lines marked on "body of shrug" schematic with right sides facing each other. Seam "sleeve" seam as shown on finishing schematic using chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern), leaving an opening on each side unseamed for cuffs. Turn garment right-side out, then work edging in the round around center edges and cuffs as shown in finishing schematic.

#### Abbreviations:

ch = chain rep = pattern repeat(s) RS = right side WS = wrong side
