

tricot13-2 Kanon Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Kanon [97% cotton, 3% polyester; 103 yds/94m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #02 yellow, 6 skeins [210g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 button (10mm/0.4")

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.6"
- cross back width 33cm/13.0"
- back length 50cm/19.7"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitches A & B: 24.5 sts and 11.5 rows
- pattern stitch C: 24.5 sts and 13 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

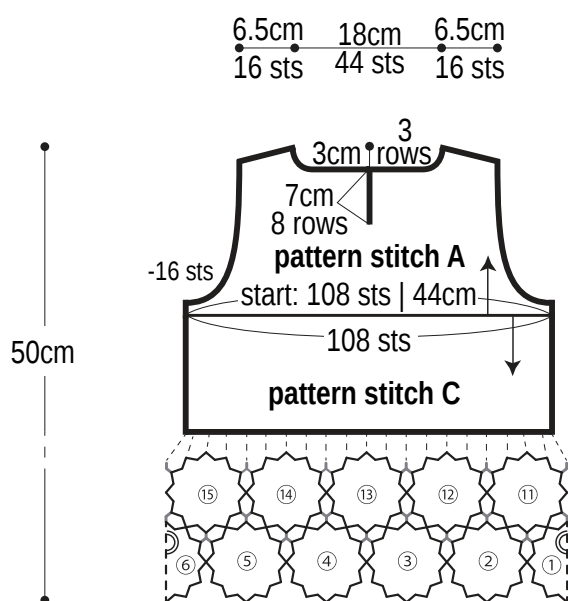
Body (back & front): For back, work foundation chain to begin. Work back in pattern stitch A. Work back neck opening at center back as shown in back schematic and back neck opening chart. After binding off, join yarn to foundation edge and work in pattern stitch C according to schematic. Work front in the same basic way as the back, but work in pattern stitch B instead of pattern stitch A and do not make an opening at the center front. Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides with chain seam. Referring to schematics and charts, crochet motifs A & B, joining them as you go.

Finishing: Work 1 row of sc edging along back neck opening, then continue by working 1 row of sc edging around neckline, including a button loop where indicated. Crochet edging in the round around each armhole. Sew button to back of garment where indicated in finishing schematic.

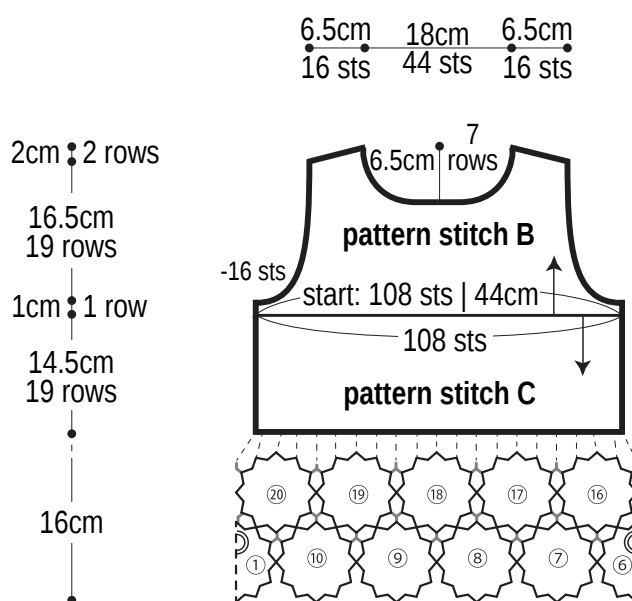
Abbreviations:

m = magic ring/circle
sc = single crochet (US)

Back 2.5mm hook



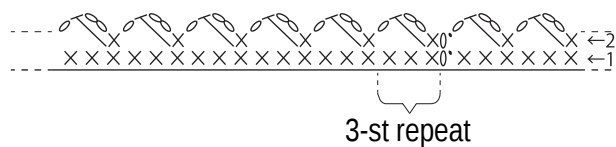
Front 2.5mm hook



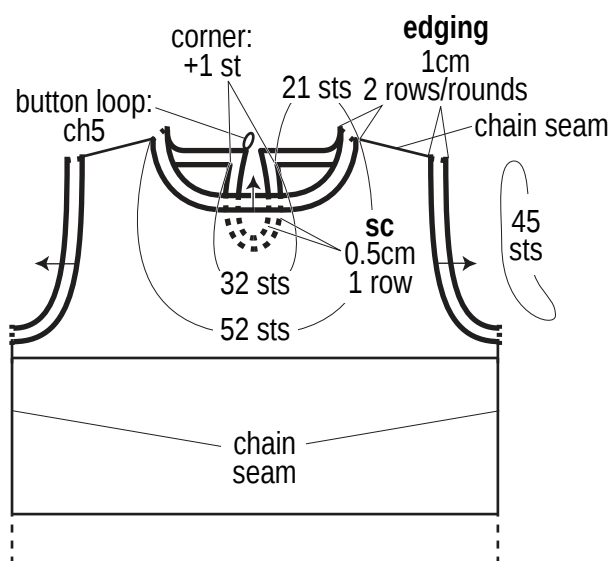
☼ = motif A (work in order from 1 to 20) Y = motif B (crochet after joining motif A pieces).

※Refer to schematic on last page to see how to join motifs together with slip stitch.

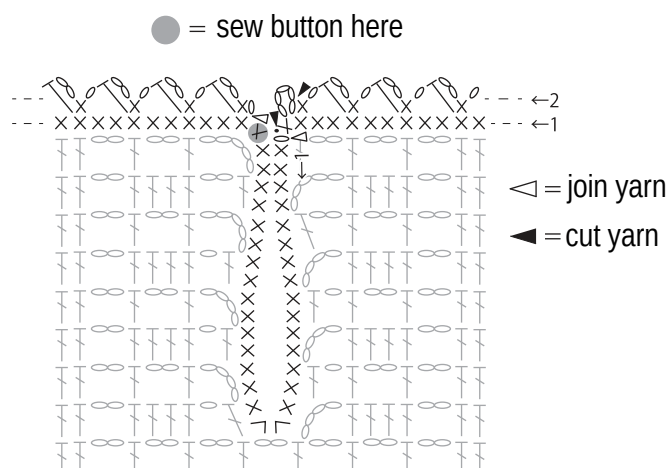
Edging



Finishing 2.5mm hook



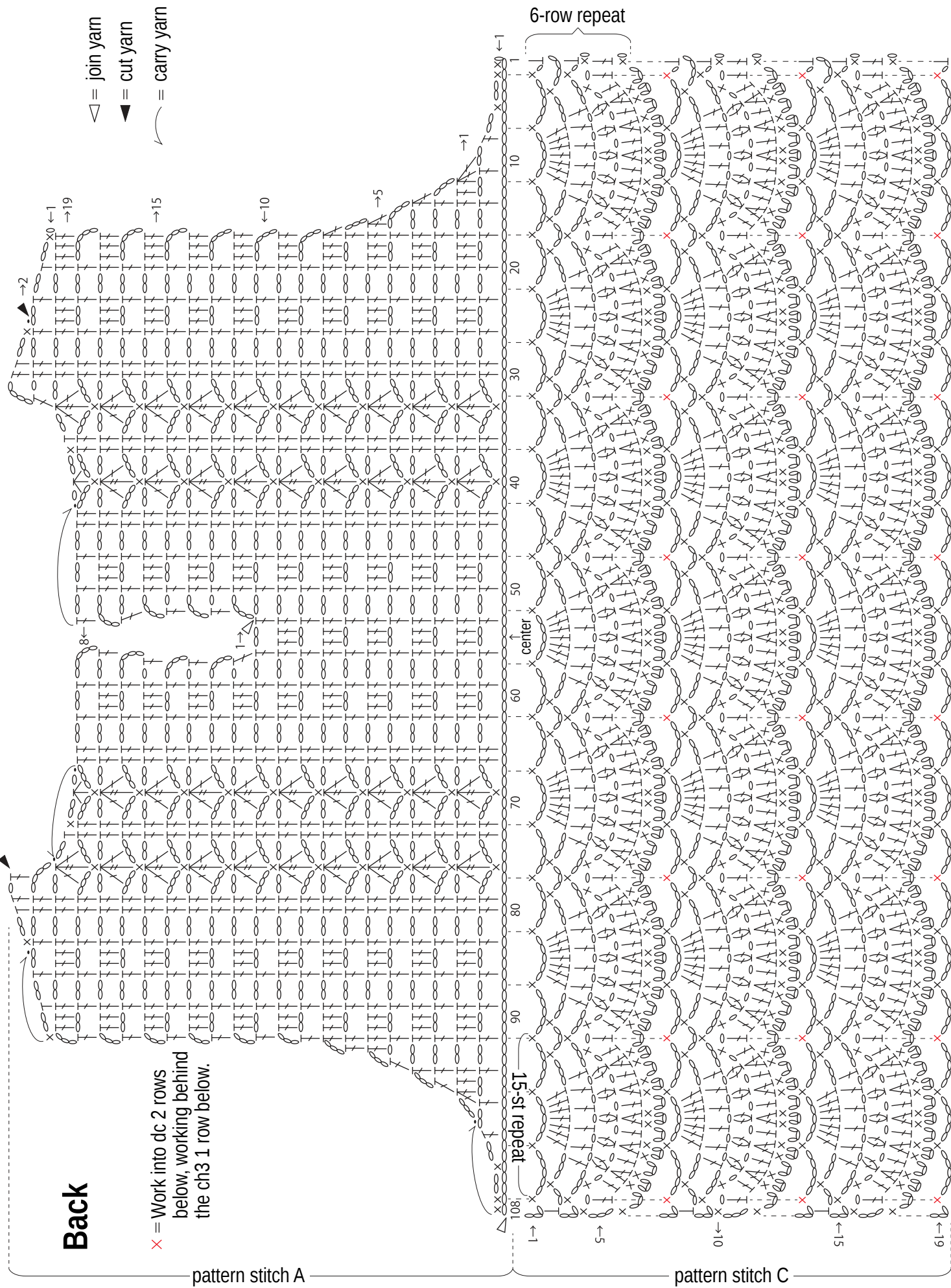
Back neck opening

 ↷ = carry yarn

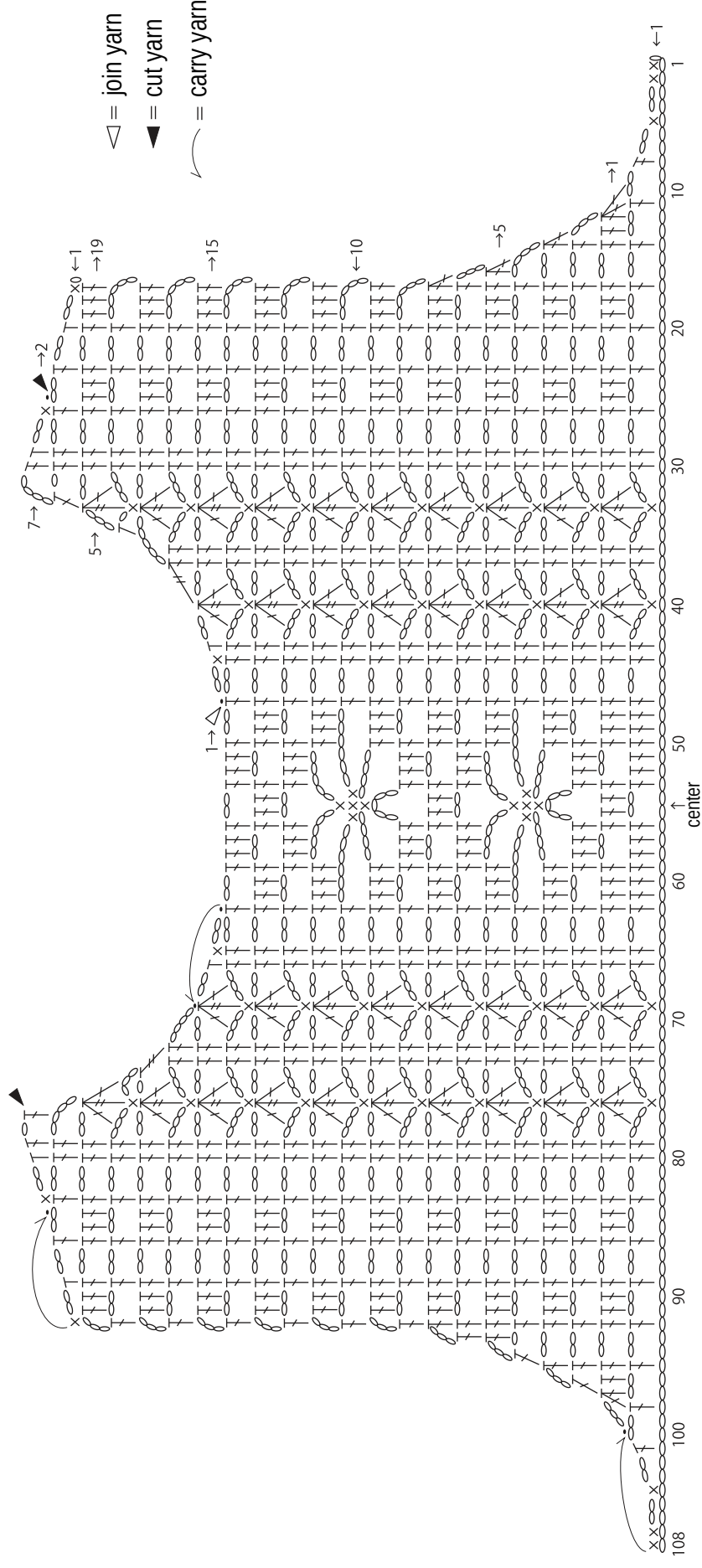


pattern stitch A

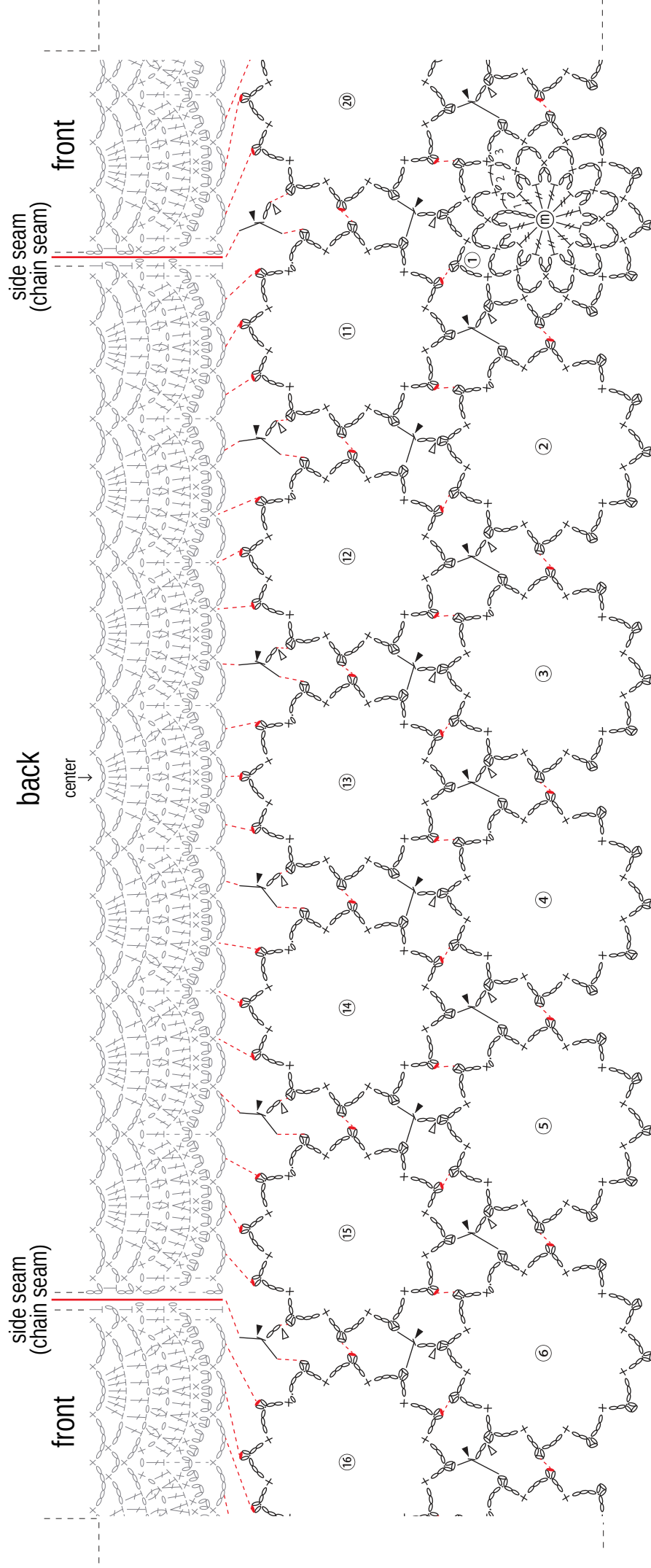
Pattern stitch B



※Work pattern stitch C in the same way as it's worked for the back.

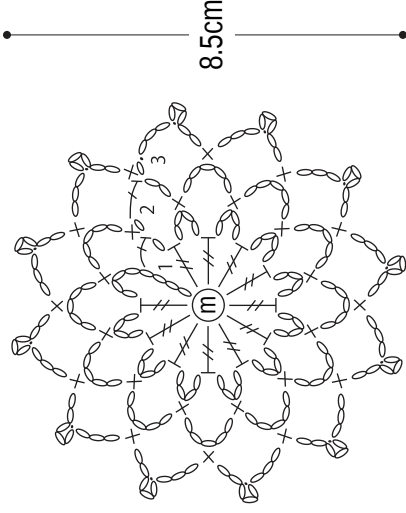
How to join motifs

✳ Join motifs on the front the same as the back, then join motif section into the round.



Motif A

Starting with second motif A, join to adjacent motifs on final round using slip stitch (see chart above).



Motif B

After joining all motif A pieces together, join yarn where indicated and work motif B. (30 places total)
