219s-10 Gradation Pouch



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - · version A:
 - color #01 white, 1 skein [5g]
 - color #27 berry pink, 1 skein [30g]
 - color #29 rose pink, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #31 powder pink, 1 skein [20g]

- version B:
 - color #01 white, 1 skein [5g]
 - color #85 navy blue, 1 skein [30g]
 - color #11 baby blue, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #84 ultramarine, 1 skein [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 white zipper per pouch (18cm/7.1")
- 1 piece of lining fabric per pouch (14cm/5.5" by 54cm/21.3")

Finished measurements:

- height (including zipper) 12cm/4.7"
- width 19cm/7.5"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 23.5 sts and 8.5 rounds
- sc (US): 23.5 sts and 25 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body of pouch: Work magic ring to begin, then work bottom in sc in the round, increasing according to chart. Continue to sides, working pattern stitch and sc in the round per chart.


Finishing: Sew zipper to mouth of pouch. Cut lining fabric and finish edges as indicated. Insert lining into pouch, then whipstitch to wrong side of zipper.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain hdc2tog = work 2 half double crochet (US) sts together m = magic ring/circle rep = pattern repeat(s) RS = right side sc = single crochet (US) WS = wrong side
