

# 218aw-14 Fontaine Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fontaine [80% wool, 20% alpaca; 103 yds/94m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
  - color #02 greige, 1 skein [30g]
  - color #05 antique gold, 1 skein [40g]
  - color #08 teal green, 4 skeins [125g]
  - color #09 charcoal gray, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #12 ink blue, 7 skeins [260g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- chest 100cm/39.4"
- center back neck-to-cuff 79.5cm/31.3"
- back length 63cm/24.8"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 21 sts and 26 rows
- pattern stitches A & B: 21 sts and 26 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary


**Body & sleeves:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then work in stranded pattern stitch and st st.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeves to armholes with crochet slip stitch seam. Sew side and sleeve underside with one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side of body).


## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off    CO = cast on    k = knit    p = purl    pm = place marker    PU = pick up    RE = row(s) even    st st = stockinette stitch    #-#-# = rows-stitches-times




## Front



## Sleeve


