578margaret Beauty Silk Shrug



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180 yds/165m per 1.1 oz./30g skein]; color #18 ice blue, 7 skeins [190g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 57cm/22.4"
- back length 41cm/16.1"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 33.5 sts and 14.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet and/or knitting style. Change hook/needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body of shrug: Work foundation chain to begin, then crochet in pattern stitch. With knitting needles, pick up stitches from working edge and work k1p1 ribbing; bind off. Pick up stitches along foundation edge and work k1p1 ribbing; bind off.

Finishing: Seam each sleeve from cuff until marker using mattress stitch. With knitting needles, pick up stitches around body of shrug (hem, front edges, and neckline) and work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

ch = chain stitch


k = knit

p = purl


pm = place marker
