

219AW-19 Christmas Stocking



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Abbey New [100% wool; 66 yds/60m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #02 rouge, 1 skein [20g]
- Pierrot Yarns Alternate Wool [100% merino wool; 98 yds/90m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #05 berry, 1 skein [15g]
- Pierrot Yarns Standard [66% rayon/viscose, 34% polyester; 481 yds/440m per 1.8 oz./50g cone]; color #5401 gold lamé, 1 cone [5g]
- Pierrot Yarns Rabbits [43% mohair, 41% acrylic, 16% nylon; 63 yds/58m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #02 felice, 1 skein [10g]
- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Bulky [100% merino wool; 44 yds/40m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
 - color #1 ivory, 1 skein [25g]
 - color #16 navy, 1 skein [10g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- Please see finishing schematic.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve desired measurements.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Some portions of the stocking are worked with 2 strands of yarn held together. Refer to schematics for details.

Body of stocking: Work magic ring to begin, then crochet in pattern stitch according to chart & schematics. Work sc loop stitches such that the loops will be on the right side of work. Work afterthought heel in dc in the round. After working last round of heel, cut yarn and thread the tail through all remaining stitches; cinch heel of stocking shut.

Finishing: Crochet a cord and fasten it to the back of the mouth of the stocking as shown in finishing schematic. Make 2 pompoms and fasten them to the stocking as shown.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain dc = double crochet (US) hdc = half double crochet (US) m = magic ring/circle sc = single crochet (US)

Stocking chart

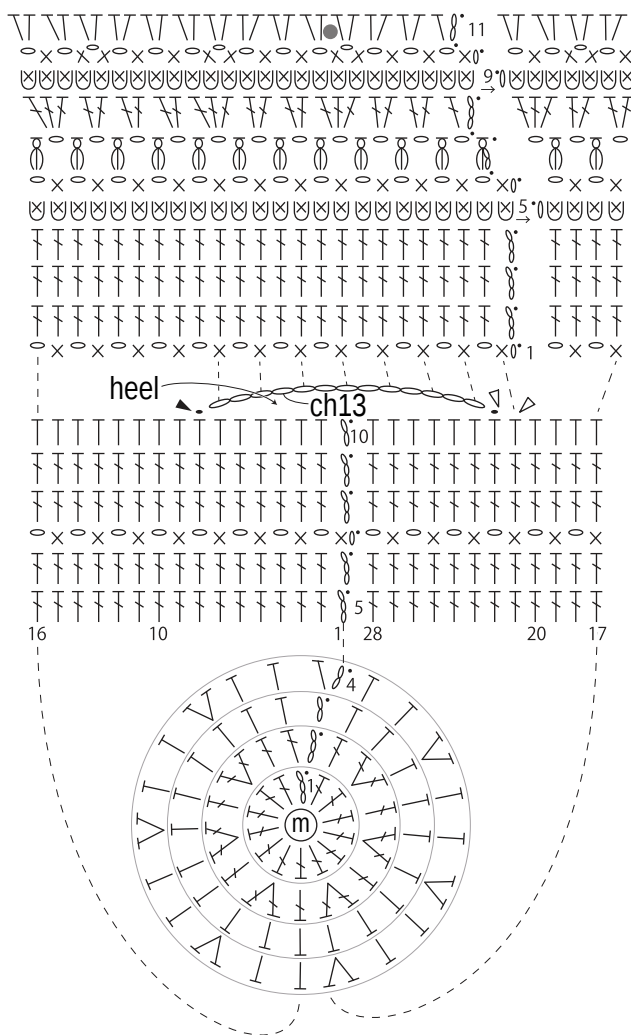
pattern stitch

◁ = join yarn

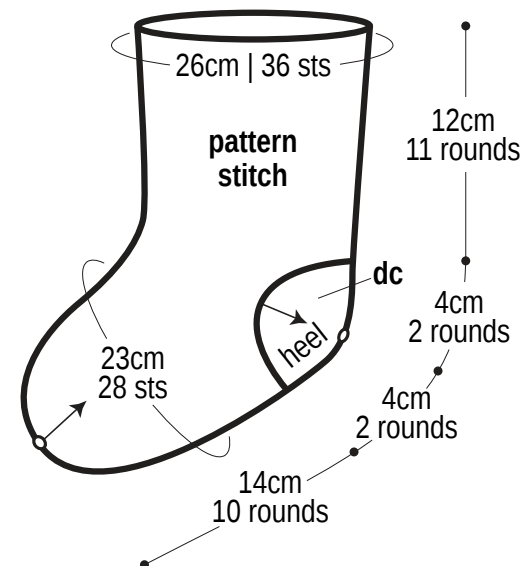
◀ = cut yarn

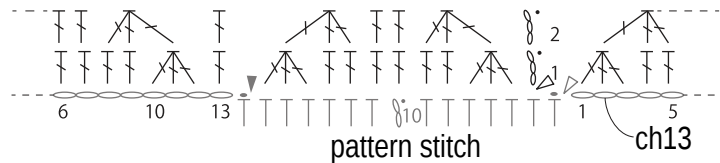

Heel: dc 2 strands (Abbey New & Standard)

After last round, cut yarn and thread tail through all remaining sts (10 sts). Cinch heel shut.

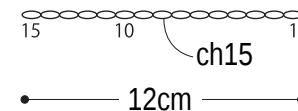


Cord for loop

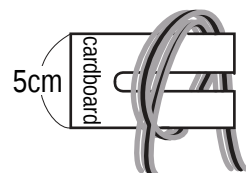

Pompom (make 2)

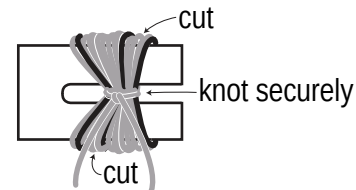
pompom 1: wrap Abbey New 25 times

pompom 2: wrap 2 strands (Soft Merino Bulky color 1 and Rabbits) 15 times

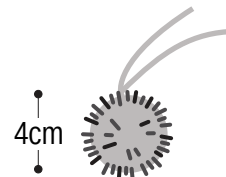
① Wrap yarn around cardboard.



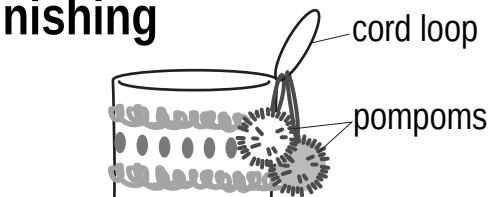
② Tie center securely, then cut each side.



③ Trim ends into a neat ball shape. Attach yarn of desired length to center of pompom (where knot is).



Finishing



- ① Seam cord to stocking, forming a loop.
- ② Tie pompoms to the loop just created.
