# 219AW-13 Pompom Poncho



#### Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Gokubuto 2 [100% wool; 57 yds/52m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #101 peach puff, 8 skeins [320g]
- Pierrot Yarns Standard Lace [100% polyester; 891 yds/815m per 1.8 oz./50g cone]; color #5101 gold lamé, 1 cone [5g]
- Pierrot Yarns Rabbits [43% mohair, 41% acrylic, 16% nylon; 63 yds/58m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #02 Felice, 2 skeins [45g]

### **Tools/Notions:**

- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

#### **Finished measurements:**

• back length 36.5cm/14.4"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 13.5 sts and 6 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### Summary

\*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body: Work foundation chain to begin, then work pattern stitch back and forth in joined rounds, increasing as indicated.

Cuffs (make 2): With knitting needles, pick up stitches where indicate and work k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Pompoms & drawstring: Make according to schematics.

**Finishing:** Seam ends of each cuff together using mattress stitch. With knitting needles, pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Crochet edging in the round along hem (not including the cuff areas). Attach pompoms to body of poncho as indicated in finishing schematic. Thread drawstring through neckline as indicated in finishing schematic.

#### Abbreviations:

ch = chain k = knit p = purl PU = pick up rep = pattern repeat(s)
