219W-05 Urban Windowpane Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Urban [100% merino wool; 394 yds/360m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
 - color #02 ink blue, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #07 deep green, 7 skeins [250g]
 - color #12 yellow ocher, 1 skein [5g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.8"
- cross back width 36m/14.2"
- back length 55cm/21.7"
- sleeve length 55cm/21.7"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• stockinette stitch & striped stockinette stitch: 22 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Note: Always use 3 strands of the same color held together.

Back body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in st st.

Front body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in striped st st. Work purl stitches where indicated on schematic.


Finishing: With crochet hook and 3 strands of yarn held together, work slip stitch up each column of purl stitches on front body and sleeves. Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. With knitting needles, pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = k knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette stitch #-#+# = rows-stitches-times


Back color #07

Front *Use color #07 for background and ribbing.




Collar: k2p2 ribbing

Vertical stripes: sleeve


(crochet) slip stitch
