

219W-07 Long Turtleneck Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Rabbits [43% mohair, 41% acrylic, 16% nylon; 63 yds/58m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #07 Rosie, 12 skeins [465g]
- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Fingering [100% merino wool; 183 yds/167m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #71 off-white, 4 skeins [160g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) and 8.0mm (US 11) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 102cm/40.2"
- center back neck-to-cuff 71.5cm/28.1"
- back length 73cm/28.7"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- k1p1 ribbing (with 8.0mm needles): 11 sts and 15 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Rabbits & 1 strand of Soft Merino Fingering).

Body (back & front) & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Work collar in k1p1 ribbing as extension of body. Bind off in pattern. For sleeves, bind off with basic bind-off method.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides of collar with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch seam. Seam each side marker at top of side slit until underarm, then continue down sleeve until cuff.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

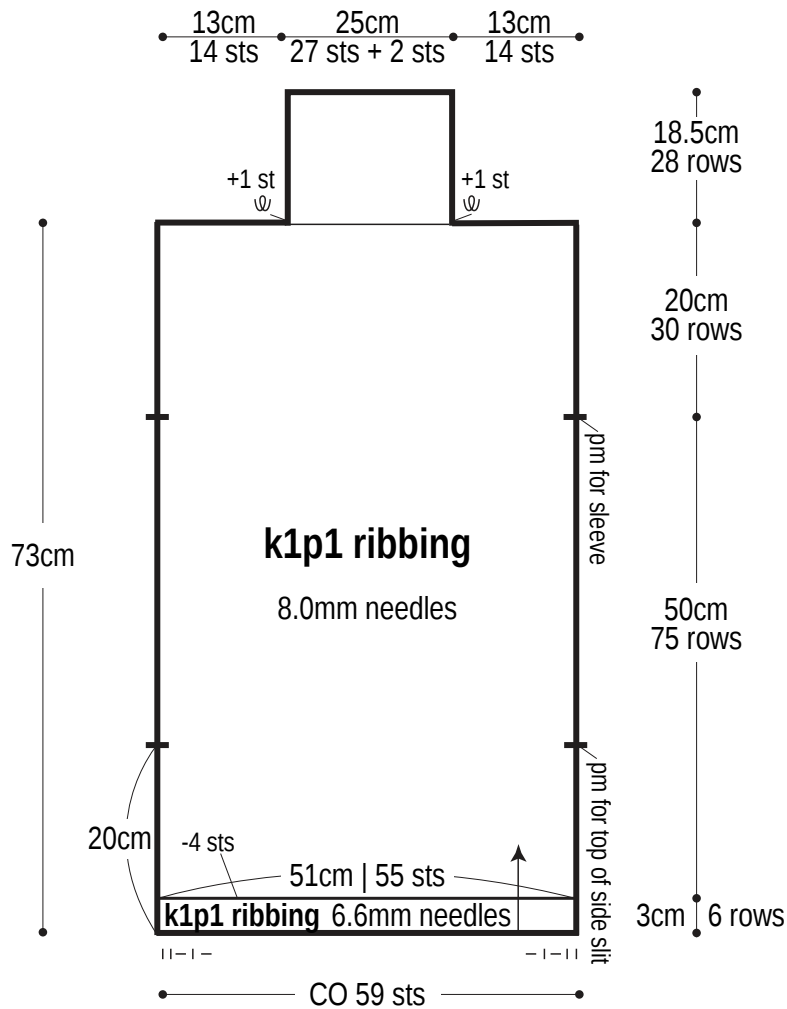
CO = cast on

k = knit

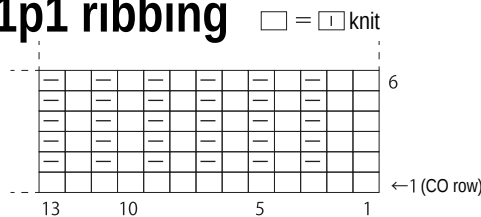
p = purl

pm = place marker

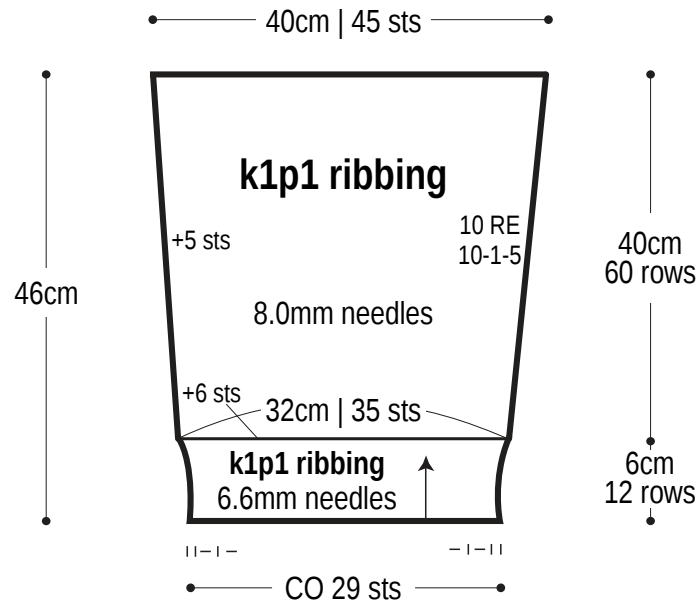
Body (make 2)
