

373sp Urban Stole Pin



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Urban [100% merino wool; 394 yds/360m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
 - version A:
 - color #03 ruby red, 1 skein [5g]
 - color #05 dark navy, 1 skein [5g]
 - version B:
 - color #07 deep green, 1 skein [5g]
 - color #12 yellow ocher, 1 skein [5g]

Tools/Notions:

- 1.5mm (US steel hook 7) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 ribbon clasps
- 6 pieces of ribbon, each 15cm/5.9" long
- 2 O-rings, 6mm/0.24"
- 3 O-rings, 4mm/0.16"
- 3 charms
- 2 pearl beads (8mm/0.3" diameter)
- 2 safety pins

Finished measurements:

- See finishing schematics.

Gauge:

- Each crochet motif should measure 5cm/2" square.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

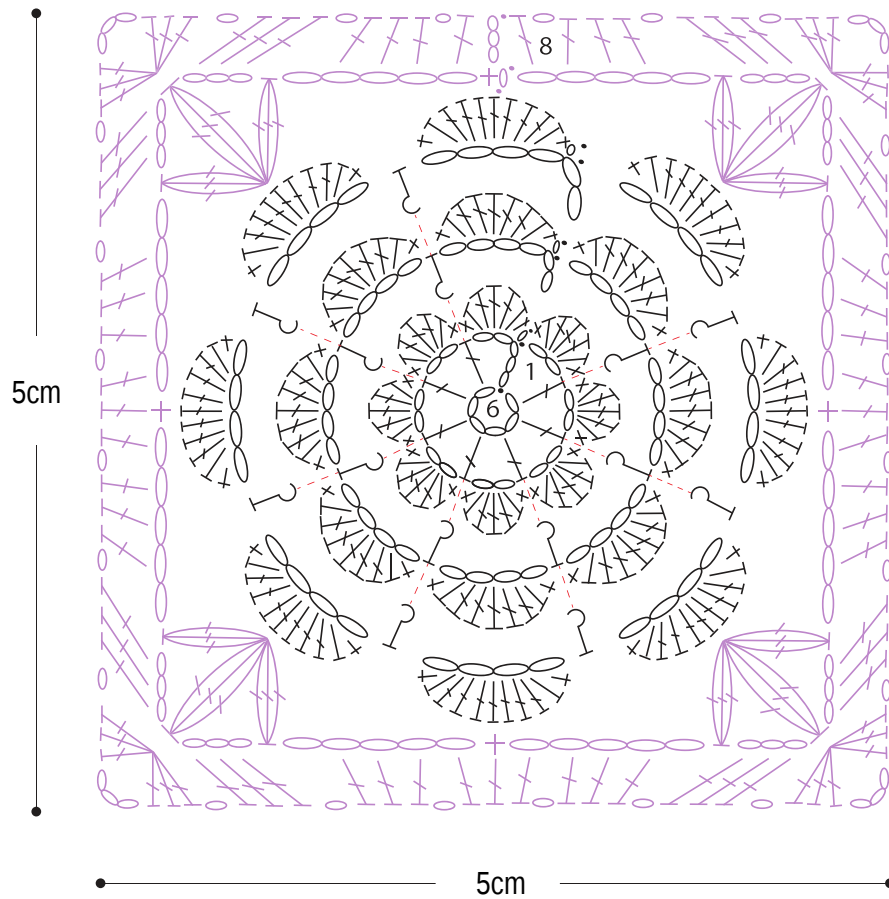
Motif: Work foundation chain to begin and join into the round. Crochet in the round according to chart.

Finishing: Cut ribbon and arrange as shown in ribbon schematic. Fasten ribbon and charm to safety pin. Seam safety pin to back of motif using whipstitch. Sew pearl bead to center front of motif.

Abbreviations:

bp = back post
ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
hdc = half double crochet (US)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side

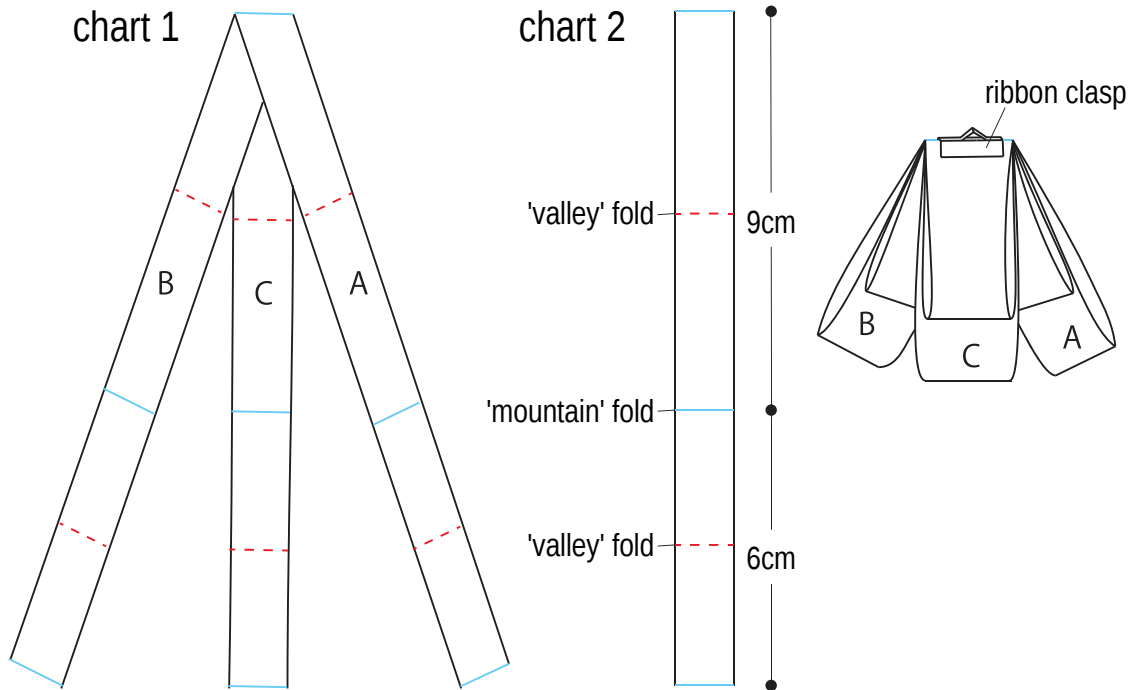
— = color no. 03 or 12

 = bp hdc

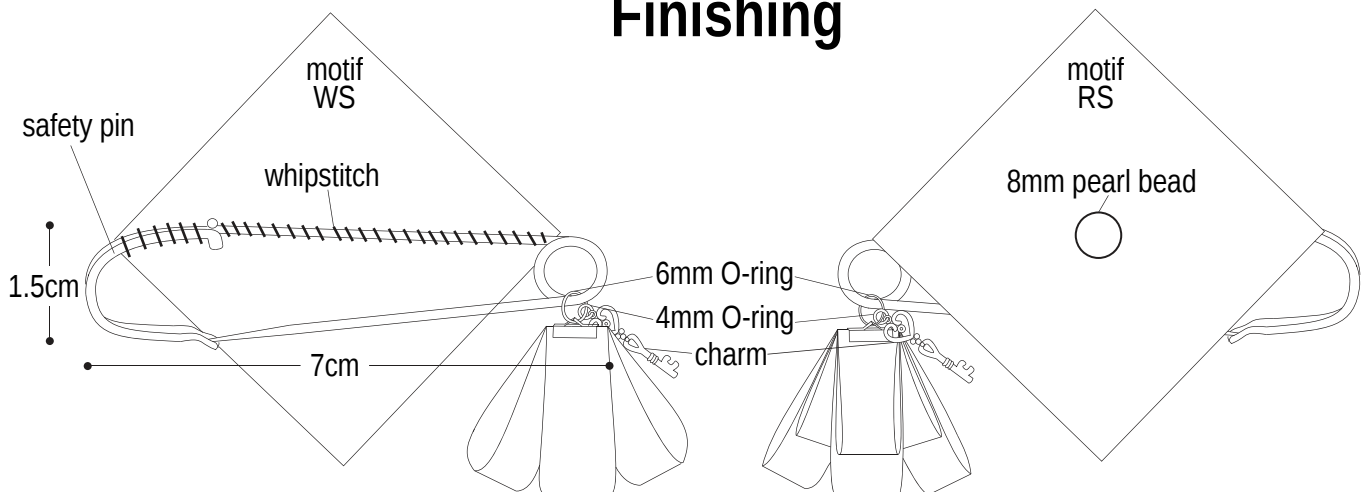
Ribbon



— = insert into ribbon clasp

Prepare 3 pieces of ribbon, each 15cm long. Overlap as shown in chart 1. Fold ribbons in order from A to B to C per chart 2. Secure top fold (marked in blue) with ribbon clasp.
