218w-05 Striped Mohair Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Bulky [100% merino wool; 44 yds/40m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #16 navy, 7 skeins [250g]
- Pierrot Yarns Rabbits [43% mohair, 41% acrylic, 16% nylon; 63 yds/58m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #02 felice, 4 skeins [150q]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10) and 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.2"
- center back neck-to-cuff 74cm/29.1"
- back length 56.5cm/22.2"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (Soft Merino Bulky): 11 sts and 16 rows
- stockinette stitch (Rabbits): 11 sts and 15 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body & sleeves: With crochet hook, ch56 with Rabbits and bind off. Make 3 more of these chains; put all 4 aside for later. With knitting needles, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in st st. Change color and needle size as indicated in schematic. Increase for sleeve by picking up new stitches from crochet chains worked earlier for this purpose (see schematic).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides/sleeves with one continuous mattress stitch seam per side of body/arm.

BO = bind off ch = chain st co = cast on k = knit p = purl pur
