

220ss-07 Carta Raglan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Carta [90% cotton, 10% silk; 133 yds/122m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #68 navy, 6 skeins [230g]
- Pierrot Yarns Pont du Gard [100% French linen; 188 yds/172m per 1.4 oz./40g skein]; color #03 glace, 3 skeins [110g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½), 3.3mm (approx. US 3), and 3.6mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.2"
- center back neck-to-cuff 74cm/29.1"
- back length 58cm/22.8"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 40 rows
- stockinette stitch: 25 sts and 38 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body (back & front): With Carta, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and then continue in pattern stitch. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (2 sts in from the edge).

Sleeve (make 2): With Pont du Gard, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (2 sts in from the edge). Pick up stitches from cast-on edge; work cuff in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Seam underarm gusset with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sleeves and sides of body with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder) p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette stitch
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
