220ss-15 Square Pouch



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Standard [66% rayon, 34% polyester; 481 yds/440m per 1.8 oz./50g cone];
 - version A: color #5401 gold lamé, 1 cone [5q]
- version B: color #5402 silver lamé, 1 cone [5q]
- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
 - version A:
 - color #11 baby blue, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #20 lime light. 1 skein [10g]
 - color #27 berry pink, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #30 baby pink, 1 skein [10g]

- version B:
 - color #01 white, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #05 lavender. 1 skein [10a]
 - color #13 turquoise blue, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #19 lime green, 1 skein [10g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat [100% cotton; 58 yds/53m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
 - version A: color #701 off-white, 1 skein [35g]
- version B: color #607 navy blue, 1 skein [35g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (approx. US G or H) Tunisian crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 zipper (20cm/7.9") per pouch

Finished measurements:

• width, length, depth (each): 10cm/3.9"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• Tunisian simple stitch: 18 sts and 16 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Note 1: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

❖Note 2: Some sections are worked with yarn held doubled. See schematics for details.

Body of pouch: Ch9 for foundation chain; bind off and save for later. Repeat (so you have 2 short chains). Work third foundation chain, then work in striped Tss per chart & schematic. Use the two short chains when indicated for adding new stitches. Bind off with slipstitch.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, match up the edges following the marks on the finishing schematic and seam with whipstitch. Sew zipper into the mouth of the pouch.


BO = bind offch = chain

Tss = Tunisian simple stitch


Body of pouch
